In the aftermath of the Camp Fire on November 8, 2018, there have been many efforts to support the basic necessities of displaced Paradise residents. Issues with food, shelter, clothing, and water have been at the forefront. We have been so blessed by the funds and gift cards that have poured in from around the country that have allowed us to minister to our local church family, neighboring church families, and to the community.

As Paradise residents begin to return to the Ridge, the matter of clean and safe drinking water has been a central focus. Although the Paradise Adventist Church, the Church Office, the Sabbath School wings, the Fellowship Center, and Adventist Community Services were all lost, there is still one building standing on our church campus. It is our well house. Prior to the fire, the well served as a connection point with our community. On any


given day of the week, local residents would come to the pump house in response to the standing invitation to fill their containers with fresh drinking water from the well.

Currently, the drinking water of Paradise is in extreme crisis due to issues with infrastructure and contamination. Safe and accessible drinking water has become a critical need for our community. This week, the function of the well was restored amidst joyful celebration! Testing is currently being done to verify its safety for drinking. Very soon we hope to be able to be a resource for fresh, clean drinking water for our Paradise and Magalia communities.

We have been blessed by the generosity of others and are so very thankful! Gift cards and financial assistance have poured in from around the country. We have been distributing these gift cards since the fire. In the weeks since the Camp Fire, temporary housing has been facilitated for nearly 50 families. This has been supported by countless volunteers and has been funded through donations

received through the Northern California Conference Camp Fire Fund. These donations have covered expenses involved in setting up temporary RV locations. This has included gravel, plumbing, sewer, trash service, porta potties, generators, and pumping services.
