LANDLINES: THE 'DINOSAUR PHONE TECHNOLOGY' THAT COULD SAVE YOU IN A CRISIS

n Friday, October 11, the Paradise SDA Church office sent out a mass telephone message. We informed those in our database, that church would be moved to Chico because of the uncertainty regarding the time parameters of our most recent widescale power outage. Our goal is to communicate to the best of our ability with you, our church family. While most of you have given us your cell phone number, we still have several folks using landlines. We've discovered many of you for several reasons did not receive the message about last Sabbath's worship service being changed. Some have indicated that they do not wish to receive robocalls from our Phonevite telephone message service by selecting the "Do-Not-Call" option that is offered at the end of the automated call. We are able to identify who has refused the calls from a printout listing the names and numbers of anyone who has selected that "Do-Not-Call" option. We also see those whose lines are busy, no answer, or have an invalid #. That information helps us identify those who may not have gotten the message and we can follow up by a continued effort to reach them. However, many landlines just don't work when there is a power outage!

During a power outage, there is an option that may help you get calls even when the power is out. POTS (Plain Old Telephone Service) landlines always work during outages. This is your old school landline that does not come through your broadband or cable TV provider. If you have old school DSL such as certain AT&T services, you probably have this. POTS service always works, regardless of power outages.

In some areas, what appear to be POTS lines are actually VOIP (Voice Over internet-Protocol) to a device on the telephone pole or other junction box on the street that provides service to your house, and these may go down during power outages. The only way to find out is to contact your telephone company and ask if your line will continue working if the power is out for a couple of days. If yes, great! You are a good candidate to be able to purchase an "old-fashioned touch-tone phone" like the one pictured below and have uninterrupted communication with the outside world during the next planned power outage. This simple purchase can make life easier during a power outage.

On March 6, 2019, the Chico and Paradise SDA churches met (in joint session) to discuss how to conduct their educational ministries for the 2019-2020 school year.

"Motion 2: Move that, effective the 2019-2020 school year, COAS and PAA operate as a single school."

During that same meeting, the following motion was also passed:

"Motion 2A: Move that a mandatory review of Motion 2, conducted by the constituency of each church, be completed by December 31, 2019."

In order to comply with Motion 2A, and to gain (and provide) information needed to make good decisions for the future of our educational ministries, we have scheduled a series of meetings. (Some of the meetings have already occurred.) The grand finale of this series will be a meeting of the Chico and Paradise SDA churches (in joint session) on December 9, 2019 at 7:00 pm.

The dates of the meetings are as follows:

Oct. 24: PAC Business Meeting

During this meeting, the PAC will act on the recommendation developed by the PAC Board regarding how to continue providing a Christian education ministry in the region.

Nov. 6: CAC Business Meeting

During this meeting, more information will be gained and distributed as we prepare for the joint meeting in December.

Dec. 9: Joint session of the CAC and PAC.

With God's help, this will be a meeting filled with joy, hope, and good decisions. We invite you to make this to process a priority in prayer.

We continue to be grateful for the opportunity to work beside you as we strive to provide Christian education to the young people of our community.


