Natural Ways to Boost Your Immune System

- Eat a wide variety of fruits (especially citrus and those with deep color), whole grains, nuts, seeds, vegetables (especially dark greens and deep color) and beans. Limit sugar, coffee, soda and alcohol intake drastically.
- 2. Supplement with herbs and vitamins. Consider astralgus, echinacea, elderberry, vitamin C and D (5000 IU daily), zinc lozenges, oregano, olive leaf oil, goldenseal, N-acetyl cysteine NAC (600 mg twice a day), turmeric, ginger.
- 3. Exercise moderately for at least 30 minutes outside every day. Strenuous exercise will diminish your immune system.
- 4. Plant a garden.
- 5. Drink at least 8-10 glasses of water daily.
- 6. Hydrotherapy hot baths, hot and cold showers (3 minutes hot 1 minutes cold for 3-5 cycles), cold baths, fomentations (hot packs to chest alternating with cold washcloth rub).
- 7. Wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds frequently throughout the day. Alcohol-based hand sanitizer or wipes are second best.
- 8. Clean your cell phone. Use a 70 percent isopropyl alcohol wipe or Clorox Disinfecting Wipes. Gently wipe the exterior surfaces of your phone (also computer, mouse, and keyboards etc.) Avoid bleach. Avoid getting moisture in any openings. Don't use your cell phone while you are eating!

Natural Ways to Boost Your Immune System (cont)...

- 9. Get out in the sunshine for 20-30 minutes to boost your vitamin D levels and your mood.
- 10. Practice self-discipline with digital exposure, news overwhelm, eating, drinking, sleeping, etc. Stick to a schedule.
- 11. Get an abundance of fresh air. Practice deep breathing inhale to the count of 4, hold for count of 2, exhale for count of 5.
- 12. Stop smoking.
- 13. Sleep 7-9 hours nightly.
- 14. Fill your mind with the beautiful: music, books, nature, good news, etc.
- 15. Cultivate relationships. Keep in contact. Minister to others.
- 16. Trust in the God who loves you. Practice gratitude. Pray. Sing. Read your Bible. Ps. 3:3 "For You O Lord are a shield around me."
