


Youth, you are invited to two Weekly Youth Online Meetings!:



NEXT SABBATH, APRIL 11, 11:00 AM

You are invited to an online Communion Service! Randy Waring will be presenting the Homily. While we are sheltering in place, let us prepare to celebrate communion together, each in our own homes. Friday evening or Sabbath morning, can be very meaningful as a family to read passages of scripture covering the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus. Join us on Facebook (FB) (https://www.facebook.com/paradiseadventist/) for the online service starting at 11 am Sabbath morning.

To prepare for this service, please consider purchasing some grape juice and perhaps some crackers. If you would like to use bread – bought or homemade will work equally well. For those who have the flour and the interest in making their own unleavened bread, the recipe is provided below.

Communion Bread

2 cups whole wheat pastry flour ½ tsp. salt 8 T oil 8 T cold water

Mix water and salt in blender, add oil slowly. Put into bowl and add flour all at once. Knead well. Roll thinner than pie crust.

Typically the dough is marked in small squares.

This time you will have enough to share more generous pieces with your family members!

Bake 10-15 min. @ 350°. Air bake pans work really well.
