To Facilitate Ease of Serving the Communion Emblems, we invite you to sit in the <u>even-numbered rows</u> when returning to the Sanctuary from the foot washing. (If more seating is necessary, please sit in the <u>middle</u> of the odd-numbered pews.)

Communion Offering — At the end of our service today, the Deacons will receive a communion offering at the doors. This offering goes into our Member Assistance Fund.

What time is good for you? Back in September 2017 our Church Board entertained a request from the Children's Sabbath Schools to begin at a later time. The leaders of these divisions were requesting a starting time of 10:00 (instead of the current 9:45 a.m.). This action would affect not just the children's Sabbath Schools, but the whole church. The board decided that we should survey the entire church and see how it would impact all of our members. 
