



PAC Worship Service – As of last Sabbath, June 20, the PAC reopened in-person worship service for those who are not considered high risk for contracting COVID-19. Worship service begins at 9:30 am outdoors on the east side of the church campus at 5720 Academy Drive in Paradise.

We plan to meet together in a safe and responsible manner. Please note that participants will be asked to <u>bring their own "printed" bulletin from the email, or to use their devices</u> to reference the bulletin during the service. <u>No printed materials will be shared</u>. Participants are also requested to bring their own mask and wear them when they are not sitting in family groups.

Please know that we fully understand that not all of our church family will be able to join us yet. We strongly encourage those who are at high risk for contracting COVID-19 (such as age, underlying health conditions, etc.), or who are experiencing any illness of any kind to continue to stay home until the crisis is past. We will continue to offer online services for those who find it best to not attend in-person. The online worship service components will be streamed on *Facebook* at 10 am and then later archived on our Church Website.



NAD Asks Members to Join in a Special Day of Prayer for Racial Justice and Equality

June 12, 2020 | Columbia, Md. | North American Division

On Sabbath, June 27, 2020, the leadership of the North American Division of the Seventh-day Adventist Church is asking its members, churches, ministries, and services to join in a special day of prayer for the deep hurt and frustration that racial injustice and inequity have caused in North America. As the conversations on racism in society and in the church continue to grow, we are urging the 1.2 million church members in the territories of Bermuda, Canada, Guam/Micronesia, and the United States to come together and prayerfully seek God's guidance and leading in our lives, especially in how we relate to one another, and how we can help stop injustice against people of color.
