

This graph shows May's offerings received as of last Sabbath for our customary monthly needs:



Church Budget: Received \$32,223 (50.75% of \$63,500 Goal)

PAA Mortgage: Received \$30,531 (304.55% of \$10,025 Payment) *

PAA Worthy Students: Received \$ 3,077 (71.08% of \$7,000 Goal)

* Includes \$13,681 received in the special May 19 Lambs' Offering Matching Challenge as well as \$14,043 Run with the Vision donations in May.
