Activities include hiking, biking, boating, fishing and swimming.





NCC Project Dominica (ACS)

Each Sabbath, about 150 members and visitors attend the Wesley Seventh-day Adventist Church on the island of Dominica. (Not to be confused with the Dominican Republic, Dominica is a small island in the Caribbean Sea, situated between Montserrat and St. Lucia. Wesley is located

on the northeast coast line.)

The congregation has had an active community services group that utilized a building adjacent to the church to provide tangible help to the community. Dominica is one of the poorest of the Caribbean countries. About 15 church members provided meals to the community on a regular basis and distributed clothing and other items to people in need.

On September 18, 2017, Hurricane Maria demolished the Wesley Community Services building. *Maranatha Volunteers International* has been asked to build a new center for the ACS group at Wesley, and the Northern California Conference ACS (Adventist Community Services) has been asked to provide both funds and volunteers to construct the building. The new building will allow the church members to resume their service to the community. They also plan to increase their outreach by adding cooking classes, health screenings, and family life seminars.
