started in January. You may have seen them in church sitting with their host families or school friends, and also in our band and choir when they perform. They are such a wonderful addition to our campus and are active in all areas, including ASB offices, sports and other activities.

Our Senior, Chris Gui, lives with the Carlson family and we will definitely miss him next year. For Street Law class, Chris is doing a special advocacy program that involves bringing together the International Exchange Students living in the Paradise and Chico area. He saw a need to make connections for these students who are so far away from their home. His first big function is a Chinese New Year's Celebration this Sunday evening in Chico. It will feature a catered Chinese dinner. Chris has been working with Chico State exchange students to help pull this activity together and he is quite excited about the project he has chosen. PAA supports him in his efforts. Next up, a Mexican Exchange Student event.

We also have a small group of students visiting us during their "summer" break. Jennifer An, our recruiter, has three 8th grade girls

and one 4th grade boy who will spend some time in those classrooms, as well as visiting Chico State, San Francisco and a few other highlights of Northern California and surrounding areas. We look forward to possibly having the girls enrolled here next school year.

New 2018 Budget

A New Year! A Clean Slate! A New Challenge!


If you missed the Church Business Meeting on Wednesday evening, February 7, it was reported that we had another successful year in 2017. The Lord has truly blessed us! And we thank **YOU** for sharing your blessings to support our many areas of church finance.

Now we start a new year with a new challenge. It was a bit of a struggle for us to cover all our expenses this last year. And with our *Run with the Vision* Capital Campaign continuing in 2018, it was felt that we needed to keep our operating expenses basically the same as last year. The 2018 **budget for our PAC Ministries Fund which was approved at the February 7 meeting totals \$755,547**. This new budget represents a \$1,757 (0.23%) increase over last year's. (You may pick up copies of the 2018 PAC Budget as well as the worksheet for the PAA 2018-2019 school year budget from the slat wall in the foyer.)

Our monthly donation goals for the *PAC Ministries Fund* (our Operating account) will remain the same as last year in order to be successful in funding our commitments to Paradise Adventist Academy and our many church ministries throughout this coming new year. These donation goals are as follows:

We are in Phase II of the campaign with all RWTV donations being applied directly to the school loan. We have retired \$349,900 of the debt since RWTV began 15 months ago. <u>Just \$557,982 to go now!</u>
