
## Our Church Finances

# To our Faithful Church Members:

Thank you . . . for your overwhelming support of our Church Finances in 2018!

On top of returning the Lord's Tithe of over \$1,013,000, you have generously donated another \$791,472 to PAC Offerings as of Sept. 30:

- \$251,250 for PAA Operating Expenses
- \$ 83,200 for PAA Worthy Students
- \$230,777 for School Loan Reduction
- \$226,245 for all PAC church ministries combined



This graph shows that for every \$1 that has been donated to PAC so far this year, 71¢ was used in one way or another for Paradise Adventist Academy!

Because we will need \$337,000

in PAC Ministries Fund donations in order to end this fiscal year in the black. (This is \$65,000 lower or 16% less than last year!)
