The human brain is considered to be the most complex entity in the entire universe, but another site of God's creative wonders is

evident even in the minute cells of our body. MIT's Gerald Schroeder explains that on average each cell in your body is

producing 2,000 proteins every second. "Each cell, every cell in your body, is selecting right now approximately 500,000 amino acids, consisting of

some 10.000.000 atoms. organizing them into preselected strings, joining them together, checking to be certain

each string is folded into specific shapes, and then shipping each protein off to a site, some inside the cell, some outside, sites that somehow have signaled a need for these specific proteins. Every second. Every cell. Your body, and mine too, is a living wonder," (Schroeder, The hidden face of God, 2001, pp. 61-62). Yet, in order to produce 2,000 proteins

> per second, the cell must have protein from outside of itself-most of which is derived from the food we eat. This is just one more scenario that causes us

to ask, 'Which came first, the chicken or the egg?' And creationists know the answer.


